




# Land use based on individual private car ownership

















### **Urban Renewal**

- Affluent, high-density residential developments in downtown neighborhoods
- Improved public transportation and infrastructure in cities
- Desire to escape from "suburban sprawl" and live closer to arts, culture and entertainment districts
- Prepared to pay higher prices for housing, if costs for transportation are reduced








## **Understanding Modal Shift**
