## **VENUE & ACCESS BY PUBLIC TRANSPORT**

Arriving by plane: Innsbruck Airport is situated in the west of Innsbruck, about 5km from the city center. From the airport take bus F (direction "Stadion") into the city, get off at bus stop "Klinik/Universität", change buses, take either bus M or O and hop off again at stop "Maria-Theresien-Straße" - from there it is only a short walk to Congress Innsbruck.

Arriving by train: The favorable location of Innsbruck (north-south axis) makes it possible for you to get there easily by train. From Innsbruck railway station take bus H (direction "Wohnheim Saggen/Schutzengelkirche") and get off at bus stop "Congress/Hofburg".
